"Pedals, Pipes, and Pinot" a Tri-Chapter Success

Thirty-five members of our three local AGO chapters gathered on April 17 at the Palladium in St. Petersburg to hear a recital on the E. M Skinner organ and then enjoyed a delicious meal together. There were two recitalists. Marco Jimenez, a 15 year old student of Dwight Thomas, performed



a three movement suite of his own composition. Everyone enjoyed the introduction when Dwight put on his best David Letterman and interviewed Marco about the piece and his other interests such as chess. Marco has only been playing the organ for two years, but he had a solid command of the instrument. His organ piece was substantial. It was challenging in both manuals and pedal and had a musicality well beyond his years. If Marco continues to compose and perform on the organ, we will be proud to say we met him at the beginning of his career.

Marco was followed by Tom Hoehn of our Clearwater Chapter, who improvised on the tune "TERRA BEATA." Tom showed off all the beauty of the solo stops of the organ and gave a thorough treatment of the tune from a gentle and quiet beginning to a middle section featuring the reeds and then back to a quiet conclusion. He also included "Amazing Grace" and probably some other tunes that I may have missed! Tom has spent a lifetime perfecting the art of improvisation and is a gifted silent film performer. It was a joy to get to know some members of our sister chapters during the meal together. It is the hope of all three deans that we will have more tri-chapter events like this in the future.

I have been asked and have agreed to serve as your dean for 2018-2019. I am grateful to those who have agreed to be installed as returning or new officers next week. We will do our best to provide another year of interesting and helpful chapter programs. I thank you for your support of the American Guild of Organists!
