PIPE ORGAN ENCOUNTER

Pipe Organ Encounters (POEs) offer teenagers and adults a rewarding opportunity to learn about the pipe organ and its construction, receive instruction from experienced faculty, visit, hear, and play outstanding instruments, and meet and interact with peers who share an interest in the King of Instruments.

The Clearwater Chapter together with the St. Petersburg Chapter is in the beginning stages of planning to host a POE in

the summer of 2022. Timothy Belk and Shawn Thomas are doing the preliminary work toward a February 2021 application deadline, but it will take many of us chapter members to make this happen. Some of the faculty has agreed to serve, but beyond that we need help with chaperones, transportation, meals, housing, publicity and more. Further details will be shared in the future. CLEARWATER CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

The Clearwater Chapter has a long history of supporting young organ students through our two scholarship funds. Both the Grom Education Fund and the Peterson Scholarship Fund exist primarily to offer financial assistance to middle/high school students studying organ with chapter member teachers. A typical grant would cover half the cost of the teacher's normal lesson fee for a semester. Other requests are considered by the board and might include full fee coverage, printed music, organ shoes, costs for a student or chapter member/officer to attend a workshop, convention, Pipe Organ Encounter, or other educational event.

Grant requests are reviewed and teachers are notified of the board's decisions in advance of the semester of study. The application form, as well as the lesson log form, is available on the Chapter website clearwaterago.com The application must be submitted to the Scholarship Chair, Tom Huffman, prior to the semester and the lesson log at the completion of the study. At that time the grant is paid directly to the teacher. Currently there is one student benefiting from the scholarship studying with Dr. Linda Pointer.




