

The Clearwater Chapter of AGO is again sponsoring a Choral Festival with area choirs, this year on November 1-2, 2014 with guest conductor Dr. James Bass, the artistic director of the Master Chorale of Tampa Bay. It will be held at the First United Methodist Church of Clearwater.

Building on the great success of last year's event with 90 singers, we invite you to join in this experience. We have chosen fewer anthems to rehearse and extended the time with Dr. Bass at the Saturday rehearsal. We will meet on Saturday morning, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. The Sunday public concert will be at 4:00 p.m.

The theme will be music of the church year—Advent through Pentecost. We have tried to keep costs to a minimum by selecting music that many already have in the music library. As you see from the list, we will also do several hymns with choir and congregation. Accompaniment will be with organ, handbells, harp, oboe, flute and trumpet. The cost will be \$10 per person with a maximum of \$100 per choir.

We hope you can plan to join with us in what will surely be an uplifting, meaningful and valuable experience for us all. In 1989 he formed the music publishing company, Wayne Leupold Editions, Inc., with the purpose of publishing organ teaching materials and organ music from all national schools and historical periods.
