Haig Mardirosian is Dean of the College of Arts and Letters and Professor of Music at the University of Tampa. a concert organist, composer, and conductor. He has performed in many of the most important concert venues throughout North America and Europe. He has over a dozen commercial recordings to his credit including well known and respected performances of the organ works of Bach, Brahms, Liszt, Petr Eben, and Jean Langlais.

For 25 years, Mardirosian served as a critic for Fanfare Magazine, the leading recording review journal in the United States, and for 26 years he has written reviews of recordings, scores, books, and New Media for *The American Organist* with his monthly editorial column, *Vox Humana*. He has also contributed articles to *The Diapason* and *The Journal of American Organbuilding*. In 1993, he traveled to Stockholm, Sweden, under the auspices

of a grant from the Swedish Institute, to research and write about the music of Otto Olsson. In sum, he has produced more than 1900 articles. He is also active as a consultant on the design and construction of pipe organs.
