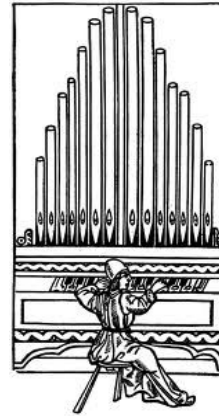

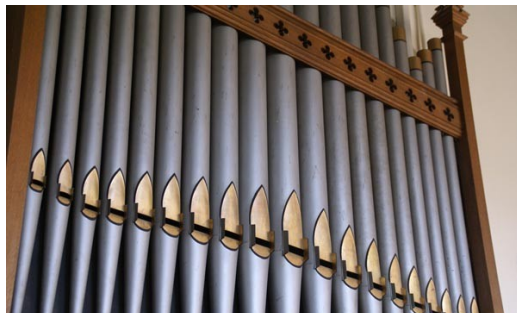

Afterwards, he studied organ with P. Pidoux and J. Langlais. Currently he is Professor of Organ and Composition at the National Conservatory in Cuneo and since 1981, has been titular organist at the Basilica of Santa Rita in Turin. From 1979 to 1994, he was the Director of Music at the Turin Cathedral.
