The Clearwater Chapter of AGO is sponsoring a Choral Festival with area choirs November 2-3, 2013 with guest conductor Dr. James Bass, the artistic director of the Master Chorale of Tampa Bay. It will be held at the First United Methodist Church of Clearwater.

Our goal is to offer our church choirs the opportunity to sing with a relatively large choral group and to experience working with and learning from Dr. Bass. The plan is to rehearse on Saturday morning, probably 9:30-Noon, and then meet back on Sunday afternoon for a public concert of the five or six pieces we rehearsed along with several congregational hymns.

We are also aware that music budgets are stretched so that this needs to be produced economically and without great expense to our choirs.

You could help at this point with your response to three points:

- Affirm that this is valuable to you and your singers and that the chosen dates of the first weekend in November fit your calendar.
- Send me two anthem titles with composer that you would like us to consider doing. Some factors in the choice should be length of 3-4 minutes, pieces that you already have in your library would be a plus or that might be common in other church's libraries, and something not extremely difficult since massed rehearsal time for each work will be 20-25 minutes.
- Give a rough estimate of the number of singers in each part you might have attending.

I am very excited about this whole idea and the end result. We will, of course, open this to all chapter members and their churches, however this letter is just to ten of you that we thought would probably be interested.

I know some of you are vacationing or on study leave, however if you could respond before our next chapter board meeting on August 7 that would be helpful. Contact information:
